**JOINT RESOLUTION OF
THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, THE
BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LITTLE LAKE CEMETERY DISTRICT,
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE GREATER LOS ANGELES COUNTY VECTOR
CONTROL DISTRICT, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE COUNTY SANITATION
DISTRICT NO. 18 OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF LA MIRADA, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MIRADA AS
SUCCESSOR OF INTEREST TO THE LA MIRADA SOUTHEAST RECREATION
AND PARK DISTRICT, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWALK AS
SUCCESSOR OF INTEREST TO THE NORWALK-SOUTHEAST RECREATION
AND PARK DISTRICT, AND THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WATER
REPLENISHMENT DISTRICT OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA
APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE NEGOTIATED EXCHANGE OF
PROPERTY TAX REVENUES RESULTING FROM
ANNEXATION OF TRACT NO. 82127
TO COUNTY LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT 10045A**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 99.01 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, prior to the effective date of any jurisdictional change that will result in a special district providing one or more services to an area where those services have not previously been provided by any local agency, the special district and each local agency that receives an apportionment of property tax revenue from the area must negotiate an exchange of property tax increment generated in the area subject to the jurisdictional change and attributable to those local agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, acting on behalf of the County Lighting Maintenance District (CLMD) 10045A, Los Angeles County General Fund, Los Angeles County Public Library, the Consolidated Fire Protection District of Los Angeles County, Los Angeles County Flood Control Drainage Improvement Maintenance District, and Los Angeles County Flood Control District; the Board of Directors of the Little Lake Cemetery District; the Board of Trustees of the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District; the Board of Directors of the County Sanitation District No. 18 of Los Angeles County; the City Council of the City of La Mirada; the City Council of the City of La Mirada as Successor of Interest to the La Mirada-Southeast Recreation and Park District; the City Council of the City of Norwalk as Successor of Interest to the Norwalk-Southeast Recreation and Park District; and the Board of Directors of the Water Replenishment District of Southern California have determined that the amount of property tax revenue to be exchanged between their respective agencies as a result of the annexation proposal identified as Tract No. 82127 is as shown on the attached Property Tax Transfer Resolution Worksheet.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The negotiated exchange of property tax revenues between the CLMD 10045A, Los Angeles County General Fund, Los Angeles County Public Library, the Consolidated Fire Protection District of Los Angeles County, Los Angeles County Flood Control Drainage Improvement Maintenance District, Los Angeles County Flood Control District, the Little Lake Cemetery District; the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District, the County Sanitation District No. 18 of Los Angeles County, the City Council of the City of La Mirada, the City of La Mirada as Successor of Interest to the La Mirada-Southeast Recreation and Park District, the City of Norwalk as Successor of Interest to the Norwalk-Southeast Recreation and Park District, and the Water Replenishment District of Southern California resulting from the annexation of Tract No. 82127 to CLMD 10045A is approved and accepted.

2. For fiscal years commencing on or after July 1, 2021, or the July 1 after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the property tax revenue increment generated from the area within Tract No. 82127 Tax Rate Area 06881 shall be allocated to the affected agencies as indicated in the enclosed Worksheets.

3. No transfer of property tax revenues other than those specified in Paragraph 2 shall be made as a result of the annexation of Tract No. 82127.



If at any time after the effective date of this resolution, the calculations used herein to determine initial property tax transfers or the data used to perform those calculations are found to be incorrect, thus, producing an improper or inaccurate property tax transfer, the property tax transfer shall be recalculated and the corrected transfer shall be implemented for the next fiscal year.
